
## Mission

## **Data Products**

- Regional and thematic datasets from collaboration with various data collection projects worldwide
- River discharge data collected at daily or monthly intervals from more than 10,000 stations in 160 countries
- Primary data providers are the national hydrological and meteorological services of WMO member states
- Worldwide user community from climate sciences and hydrometeorology
